Volunteer Uniform

The 2017 Volunteer uniform consists of a polo shirt to be worn with **NAVY** shorts, slacks or skirt. We ask that you wear your uniform only on the days that you are volunteering. Your Volunteer Badge serves as your ticket to enter the tournament on the days that you are working.

Scoring and Marshal Training

Mandatory training for **marshals** and **walking scorers** will be held Monday, August 7 at 6 p.m. - **Walking Scorers** at the **Hall of Fame, Marshals** in the **Volunteer Tent.**

Parking

You will enter through the **Front Gate** and follow the signs to Volunteer Parking (located on Kingswood). Transportation will be provided to the Clubhouse. **The back gate to Highland Springs will not be open.**

Check-In

Please check in at the **Volunteer Registration and Food Service Tent** thirty minutes prior to your assigned shift (unless you have been instructed otherwise). **In CASE of EMERGENCY, this is our only way to know if you are on the grounds.**

Food Service

The Hiland Dairy Volunteer Registration and Food Service Tent volunteers will be grilling hot dogs and serving refreshments for your enjoyment on the days you are volunteering. Coffee, bagels and donuts will be waiting for early volunteers. Hot dogs are served between the hours of **11 am and 2 pm**. All food in the Volunteer Tent is donated by generous vendors and area businesses.

Weather

Unless there is lightning or heavy rain, golf play will continue. Please come prepared for showers. In the case of inclement weather, please return to the Volunteer Tent for further instruction. Typically the weather is hot and humid. Be sure to use plenty of sunscreen and stay hydrated.
